The November 2006 Porsche of the month belongs to Joelynn, Dana and Will Smith with their 1983 911 SC.

It all began in 1973 when I called about a Porsche ad in the newspaper. It was for a 1968 orange Targa with a soft zipper back window. The guy was asking \$4,000. In 1971, you could buy a Hemi-Cuda for \$3,800. I was only 18 at the time and I realized I could not buy this car but I began admiring the Porsche from then on.

I finally came to a point that I realized if I was ever going to own a Porsche, it was time to buy one rather than continuing to dream about them. I started looking and looked at two or three that were around 1979's. They ran fast and stopped quick but their

looks were worn.

One day I told my neighbor I was looking for a 911 and his friend had one but it wasn't for sale. I wanted to look at it to make a comparison to the others I had been looking at. The guy said he hadn't really been thinking about selling but he might. It was in a very dark shed with another car. The only thing I could tell was that it had polished wheels and a T-Tray tail.




